Rector's Welcome and Approval of Resolutions

President Reveley provided an update on planning to host a potential presidential or vice-presidential debate in 2016. The Rector presented a resolution to authorize the university to offer full financial support and engage in other expenses from available funds related to preparation to host a 2016 national debate, in consultation with The Commission on Presidential Debates. Mr. Mobley so moved, Mr. Wertz seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.
