The Rector welcomed new and returning members of the Board. President Reveley provided an update regarding the Joan Perry Brock Center, the SACS-COC re-affirmation process, policy matters related to tuition nationally and statewide, and admissions, including perspective regarding the recent U.S. Supreme Court decision holding that the use of race as a factor in admissions violates the U.S. Constitution. He said there is little practical impact on Longwood given that Longwood already was not using race as a factor in admissions. On behalf of the Office of the Attorney General, Cameron O’Brion provided further perspective regarding the findings of the opinion, and re-iterated he does not see practical impact on Longwood’s current admissions practices, but said the University will ensure it is followed carefully going forward.
