## Longwood University Board of Visitors to consider Tuition and Fees for 2025-2026 Academic Year

The Longwood University Board of Visitors will meet on the campus of Longwood University on Thursday, June 5, 2025 at 1:00 p.m. The Board is expected to take action on tuition and mandatory fees for the 2025-2026 academic year. Tuition and E&G fee increases between \$0 - \$9 per credit hour and auxiliary fee increases between \$12 and \$18 per credit hour will be considered.

Revenue from any tuition and fees increase will support state-mandated faculty and staff compensation and benefit increases as well as inflationary cost increases for materials and services.

The Board will accept public comment at the beginning of the meeting prior to any vote on tuition and fees.
